1. Host a game or activity. Your group can have an 8' x 10' space to host a game or activity for kids and parents. If you want to offer small prizes or gifts to those who participate, consider candy or something promotional like a water bottle with your logo. To promote your organization, have information available on ways the community can be part of your mission. Please be creative. Consider activities or games that relate to your groups purpose - Exp. art club or art school : small art project for kids; dance school : tango lessons for kids and adults; youth group : face painting. Make it fun! We have lots of space, so if your idea requires more, just let us know.

2. DUNKING BOOTH: Raise money for your organization by taking charge of the dunking booth for one hour. If you are a school or church, select two or three individuals from your organization (such as your principal, pastor, favorite teacher, boss) to be 'dunkees' for twenty minute shifts. Promote the event among your student or church body. What kid doesn't want to be the one to 'dunk' the principal? If you would like to request a nominal fee from participants (1 - 2 dollars per three chances), this can be a great (*and fun*) opportunity to raise money for your group. You keep all proceeds. If you would rather not charge, that is fine too. Either way, there is no cost to you, just a good time for all!


